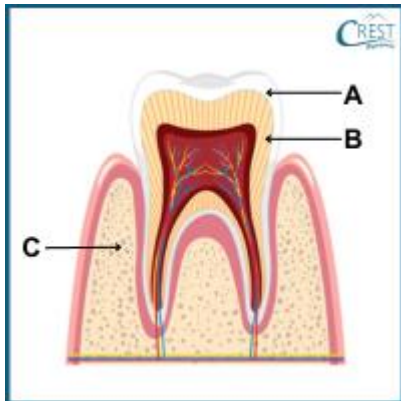

1. Name and label the hardest part of the teeth in the picture below.



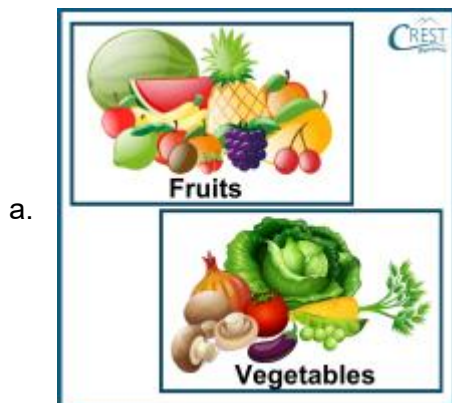

5. Ollie's brother is approximately 5 years and 11 months old. What is the probable dental change occurring at this age?

- a. The brother is developing permanent molars.
- b. The brother is experiencing tooth decay.
- c. The brother is getting his first set of baby teeth.
- d. The brother is losing his baby teeth to allow space for permanent teeth.

Answer Key

- 1. c - Enamel is the hardest outer layer of the tooth that protects it from decay. It is the visible white part of the tooth and provides a strong protective covering.
- 2. a - The picture shows incisors, which are the type of teeth that help us bite into our food.
- 3. b - Sugary foods can contribute to the growth of bacteria in the mouth, which produces acids that can damage the teeth and lead to decay.
- 4. d -
Molars: 12 in number, helps us crush and grind our food.
Canines: 4 in number, help us tear our food.
Premolars: 8 in number, help us crush and grind our food.
- 5. d - At around 6 years of age, children often start to lose their baby teeth as part of the natural tooth development process. The baby/temporary teeth begin to loosen and fall out to make way for permanent teeth.
